

Liberated Color Challenge

Completed Projects Due – Sept. 13, 2010

Size – your choice

The challenge is to let the color inspire your design and to take advantage of the ideas presented in our pre meeting demos – to do something “liberated”

RULES

1. The paint chip you drew at the guild meeting will be the focus color for your quilt. You MAY NOT swap your paint chip with anyone else.
2. You can use as many values of your focus color as you wish.
3. In addition to the paint chip color you MAY use its complementary color (the dark, light or medium values of it) in your quilt along with A COMBINATION OF THESE NEUTRALS; white, black or beige.
4. Within your quilt design you must incorporate “shape within a shape blocks” or examples of “liberated blocks” that have been demonstrated in the pre-meeting Parts Departments sessions or that can be found in Liberated Quiltmaking II by Gwen Marston – now available at amazon.com or the AQS site.

** Please save your paint chip and attach it to your finished project when you bring it to the Sept. guild meeting.

Prizes will be awarded to:

- The quilt that is the most “liberated” in its design
- The quilt that is the best interpretation of its focus color in its design
