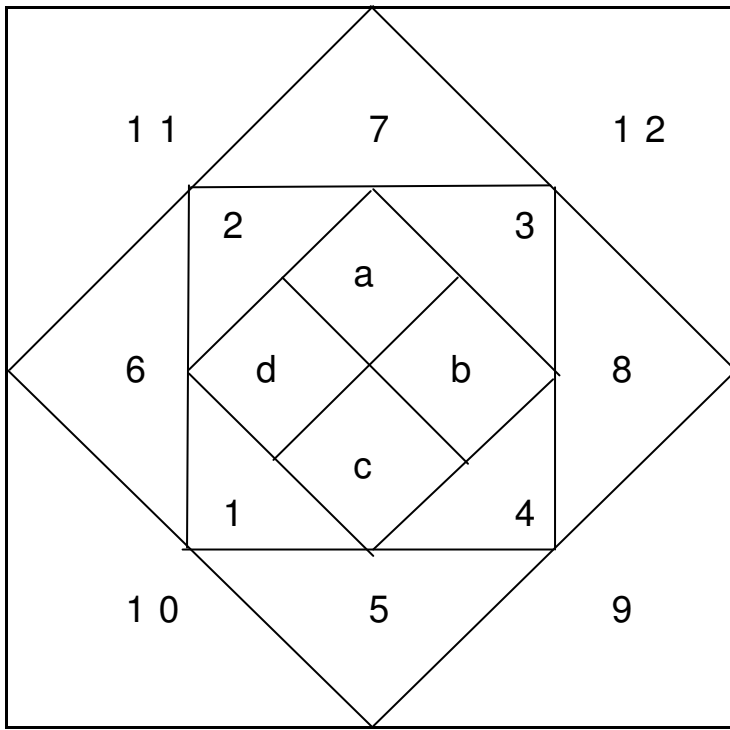


**PAPER PIECING PATTERN  
OCEAN WAVES LOGO - NAME TAG**



**GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR CREATING YOUR NAME TAG**

**\*\* IF you have never paper pieced before - ask any guild member for assistance with this process.**

1. Duplicate the above pattern on foundation paper or a light weight piece of copy paper.  
Cut out pattern with 1/2" border on all sides.
2. Select two colors of fabrics - traditional logo colors are light blue and white.
  - the light color will be placed in sections: a, c, 1, 3, 6, 8, 9, 11
  - the second color will be placed in sections b, d, 2, 4, 5, 7, 10, 12
3. Cut your fabric into squares or strips that are generously larger than the section they will cover - you will be using a 1/4" seam allowance in your paper piecing so allow at least an 3/8" border around ALL sides of the squares or strips you cut.
4. Assemble the four patch block in the center and THEN place it on the paper piecing pattern, aligning your seams with the lines of the pattern.
5. Following the numbers of the pattern, stitch each section onto the pattern, trim & press.
6. Add your name to your badge.
7. Finish by: quilting and binding or sewing a backing and turning.
8. You can attach a pin back or some members attach a cord or ribbon to their name tag so they can wear it around their neck.
