

ROTARY CUTTING DIRECTIONS FOR POSTAGE STAMP QUILT

KEY:

Numbers inside () = the number of pieces needed to complete that segment

WOF = width of fabric

** OR = alternate cutting method follows

BORDER 1

A = 1 ½” square

B = 2” x 1 ½” rectangle

C = 2 ½” square (2) cut in half

D = 2 ½” square (4)

E = 3” square (4) colorway 1

3” square (2) colorway 2

F = 2” square ~ TRADITIONAL METHOD

** OR 2” strip WOF ~ SEMINOLE METHOD

G = 3 ¼” square (8) cut diagonally 2x colorway 1

3 ¼” square (2) cut diagonally 2x colorway 2

Strips – 1 ½” x width of square [the book says 12” mine was 13”] (4)

1 ½” square (4)

BORDER 2

2A = 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangle (56)

** OR 3 1/2" squares (12)

2B = 1 1/2" square (112)

** OR 2" square (48)

2C = 3" square

BORDER 3

3A = 3" x 2" rectangle (28) colorway 1

** OR 3" WOF strips ~ SEMINOLE METHOD - part of demo on April 2, 2012

3" x 2" rectangle (16) colorway 2

3B = 3 1/2" square (20) cut diagonally 2x = (80 quarter triangles)

3C = 3 1/4" square (4)

BORDER 4 – SEMINOLE PIECING

4A = 2 1/4" strip WOF (8)

4B = 2 1/4" strip WOF (4)

4 1/4" strip WOF (8)

4C = 2 1/2" square (8 of EACH color)

BORDER 5

5A = 1 3/4" squares (216)

** *In the quilt Liza uses 12 different fabrics.*

** *You are making 24 Nine Patches.*

** *The frequency of fabric is not equal*

** *Frequency ranges from 4 – 26 (2/10s, 2/22s, 2/23s & 1 each 24, 20, 18, 14)*

5B = 6 1/2" square (6) cut diagonally 2x

5C = 3 1/2" square (8) cut diagonally

5D = 5 3/4" square

BORDER 8 – FLYING GEESE

Traditional Piecing:

8A = 9 1/2" x 3 1/4" (80)

8B = 3 1/2" square (160)

8C = 4 1/4" (2 in EACH color)

8D = 1 5/8" strip (2) WOF, cut into 16 lengths to frame cornerstone blocks.

** Seminole Piecing instructions will be shared with the Flying Geese demo on April 2, 2012.

BORDER 9

9A = 2 1/4" squares (36 nine patches)

9B = 8 1/2" square, cut diagonally 2x

9C = 9 1/2" square, cut diagonally

9D = 7 5/8" square (4)

BORDER 10

3" strips – measured to width of quilt
