Teddy Bear Instructions

Patterns

- Each bear pattern is in two parts as a PDF file, on the OWQG
- website. Just click on the underlined link for.
 Teddy Bear Upper Body pattern and Teddy Bear Lower Body pattern
- Print the pattern and join the two sections. You will be able to see the outlines to align the two pieces and join them.
- Transfer the pattern to freezer paper
- Hint freezer paper can be ironed on material many times, instead of pinning to the material each time.

Assembly

Bears should be made from 100% cotton material, fleece, corduroy, red/white/blue material, plaids, children's pattern, etc Bears made from red, white & blue fabric are preferred. Small scale child prints can also be used.

- 1. Cut 2 pieces of fabric, you need at least a 14" by 14" piece of material.
- 2. Put right sides together.
- 3. Pin pattern to the fabric
- 4. Cut the pattern 1/4" outside the tracing lines of the bear
- 5. Sew on the traced line leaving an opening for turning.

Remember to shorten stitches when sewing

- 6. Clip all curves
- 7.Turn right side out and stuff, making sure that head, arms and legs are tightly stuffed
- 8. Whip stitch the opening closed
