

Pillowcases for Hope

FABRIC INCLUDED IN THE KIT

3/4 yard for main body - 27" x 40.5"
1/4 yard for cuffed top - 9" x 40.5"
Accent strip - 1-2" x 40.5"



INSTRUCTIONS *Use 1/4" seams throughout

Step 1: Iron the accent strip in half long ways, wrong sides together.

Step 2: Lay out the 3/4 yard main body piece with right side up with the 40.5" across the top.

Step 3: Lay the accent strip on the top edge of the body, matching raw edges.

Step 4: Lay the cuffed top, wrong side up, matching the raw edge to the top of the accent strip.

Step 5: Put in a few pins at the top to keep the 3 layers together. Baste layers together.

Step 6: Arrange the main body on a flat surface with wrong side up and basted seam at top.

Step 7: Carefully roll up the main body until the right side of the cuffed top shows.

Step 8: Take the bottom of the cuffed top, and pin it to the top edge of the cuffed top, matching all raw edges. The body of the pillowcase is now rolled up inside the tube of the cuffed top.

Step 9: Sew a 1/4" along this raw edge, being careful not to catch the rolled up main body of the pillowcase inside the tube.

Step 10: Carefully pull the main body out of the tube, fold in half lengthwise Right Side out and trim (approximately 31" x 21").

Step 11: Pin the raw edges and sew the pinned edges using a scant 1/4" seam.

Step 12: Turn pillowcase wrong side out and press seam flat.

Step 13: Sew the same edges using a 3/8" seam.

Step 14: Turn pillowcase right side out, press.
